Change in management team of Gebr. Bode GmbH & Co. KG, Kassel

Munich / Kassel, 13 September 2011 – After more than nine years in the service of Gebr. Bode, for personal reasons Harald Gieren (52) asked the Executive Board of Schaltbau Holding AG to terminate his working contract, which was originally due to expire at the end of 2012. After holding further positions, including those of head of finance / controlling and managing director of subsidiaries of Thyssen Telecom AG, Dr Kremer worked as managing director of two independent entities of the Henschel Group in Kassel before becoming managing partner of Henschel Antriebstechnik GmbH in 2006.

Dr Ernst Raphael and Dirk Christian Löchner continue unchanged as members of the board of management.
